

Case: Homicide, Criminal Defense

A non-English speaking laborer was charged with the brutal slaying of a barroom acquaintance who's badly beaten body was found in an urban park. The defendant maintained his innocence and claimed that a notorious gang member, known only by his street moniker, committed the crime. Attorney for the defendant requested surveillance to identify, locate and document the activities of the reputed gang member.

Surveillance efforts provided substantive information about the alternate suspect, which supported the defendant's claim of innocence. The jury acquitted the defendant on all charges.
